





- Blue hour
- Aperture priority
- Exposure compensation
- ISO 100
- Use polarizer?






My Current Process

- Be there (in plenty of time)
- Find something interesting
- The scene dictates camera placement (reduce mergers)
 - Move side to side, forward and back and up and down
- Set up the tripod and camera
- Turn off Image Stabilization
- Compose the shot
 - Zoom to eliminate distractions
 - Adjust the head (avoid tilting if possible)
 - Is polarization needed (or shoot both with and without)

- Set exposure using the histogram (the light meter doesn't see time's affect)
 - Manual mode
 - What needs to be in focus? (aperture)
 - White balance (daylight)
 - What shutter speed? (depends on conditions)
 - O Are filters needed to achieve that?
 - O What ISO to accommodate the above?
 - o Is bracketing needed?
- Back button focus or manual focus (no need to refocus once it is focused)
- Take the shot (2 second timer)
- Review (look for the affect, histogram and blinkies)
